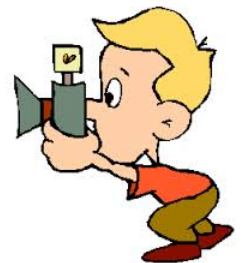

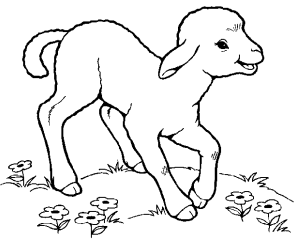
4-H Photography Contest

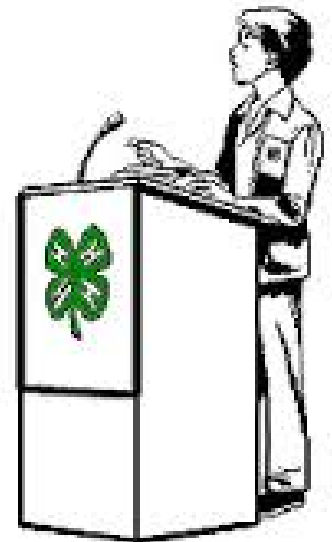
